The [ANZ A320](#) is really a beauty wearing special "All Blacks" colors of the national Rugby team. You will also find additional text on the sticker indicate that this is also the "First Delivery to Air Lease Corporation".

Well, didn't Airbus already issue the [CAL A330-300](#) sticker back in 2004? Yes indeed, but the latest sticker has a slightly different colour and a glossy finish.

The [MAS A330-300](#) is wearing the new livery with the latest style of aircraft paintings.

Even though the [RJA A340-600](#) sticker is clearly pointing out that this is a government aircraft (upper titles: "The Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan") I have listed that sticker under the [Royal Jordanian](#) chapter, because that aircraft is operated by RJA for the government.
